Position Description:

The organist plays the organ for the weekly liturgical service on Sunday mornings and for special services and events as needed. The organist seeks to honor Jesus Christ in all interactions as a representative of His church.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Consult with pastor(s) regarding the theme of each worship service, selection of hymns, and selection of liturgical setting.
2. Provide liturgical Divine Service Settings for communion, non-communion, and 5th Sundays unless directed by pastor(s) to change the format.
3. Play organ for other services as needed, including, but not limited to, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day.
4. Work with the choir director as occasion arises.
5. Warm up and rehearse the psalmist each Sunday.
6. Provide for a substitute when not able to be present.
7. Utilize available technology (for example, PowerPoint presentations) to prepare music to be used in services is desirable or have a willingness to learn the program needed for the services. The PowerPoint is generated from software called Lutheran Service Builder in conjunction with our hymnal, *Lutheran Service Book*.
8. Be familiar with the organ at St. Luke's – Rodgers OXFORD 940 with PR-300S MIDI device.
