The Immunization Form is required by the State of Washington prior to school entrance for all children. Students will be enrolled in the order in which we receive <u>completed</u> forms and registration fee. *(Returning students do not need to complete a second immunization form unless new vaccines and/or immunizations have been administered since completion of last received form.)* 

Please note that the **first tuition payment is due July 1<sup>st</sup>.** The second payment is due September 15<sup>th</sup>. All payments thereafter are due by the 15th of each month.

We look forward to a year filled with exciting growth for your child. By providing your child with a safe environment surrounded by loving, caring Christian teachers, developmentally appropriate curriculum, positive social interaction, and meaningful experiences and activities, we will, with our Lord's direction, nourish the seed that has been planted in your child's life, a seed that will grow and continue to blossom.
